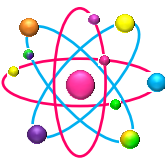

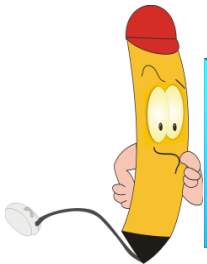
Know the contents

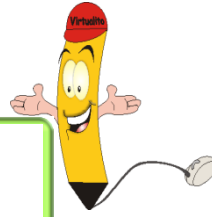
Depending on where you are located, we can speak of rural communities, which take place in the countryside and urban communities that develop in towns and cities.

All family members are part of a community.

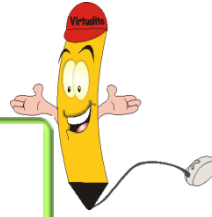
The families, according to their customs and traditions come together to celebrate and share special dates.

In the family there are standards of cooperation and coexistence to achieve harmony.



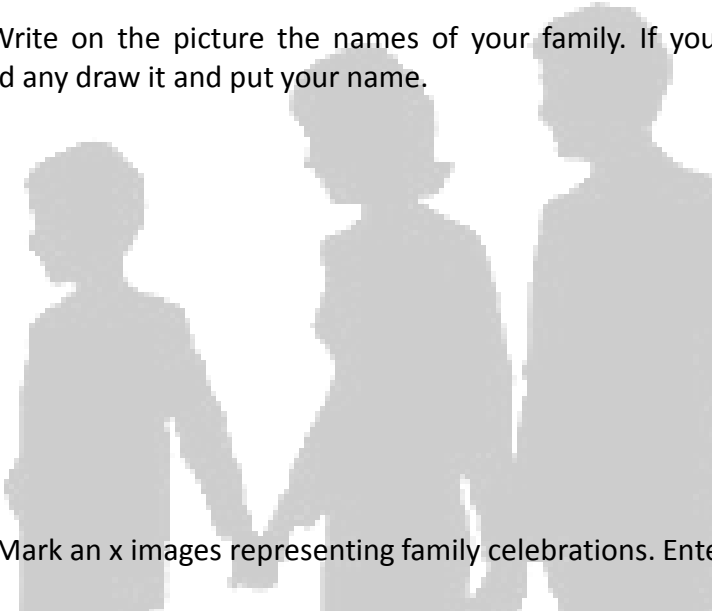

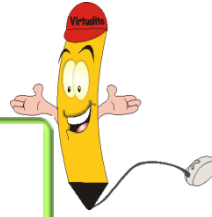


The school community is a valuable educational resource that can be used as a way to encourage students to care and protect the living environment, and strengthen feelings of belonging to the place of origin.

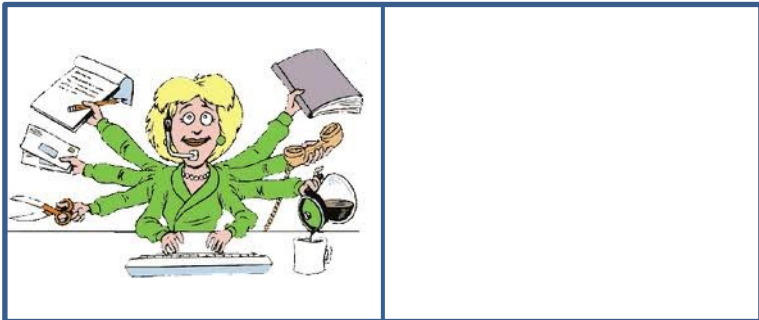
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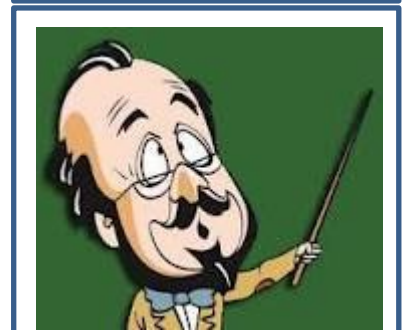
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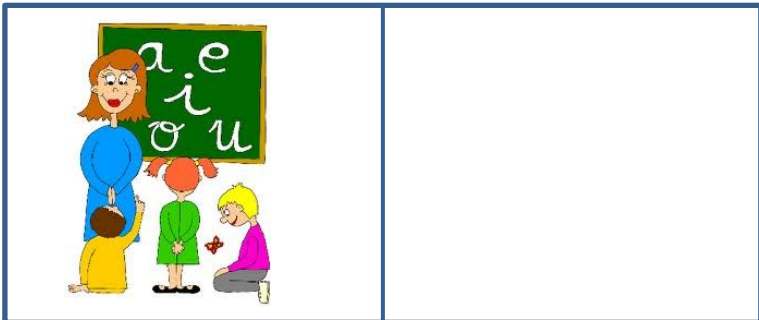
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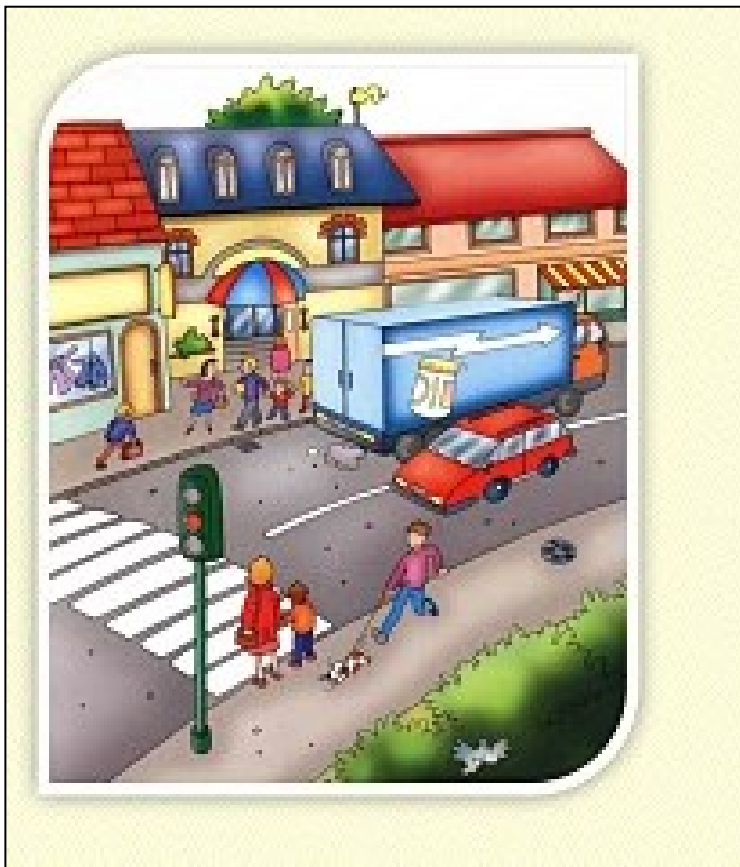


My neighborhood

All people who live in your neighborhood are part of your community.

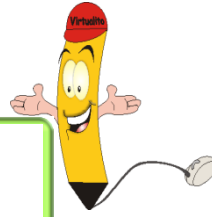
Not all neighborhoods are the same. Some have modern buildings and large avenues, others have old houses and historical monuments.

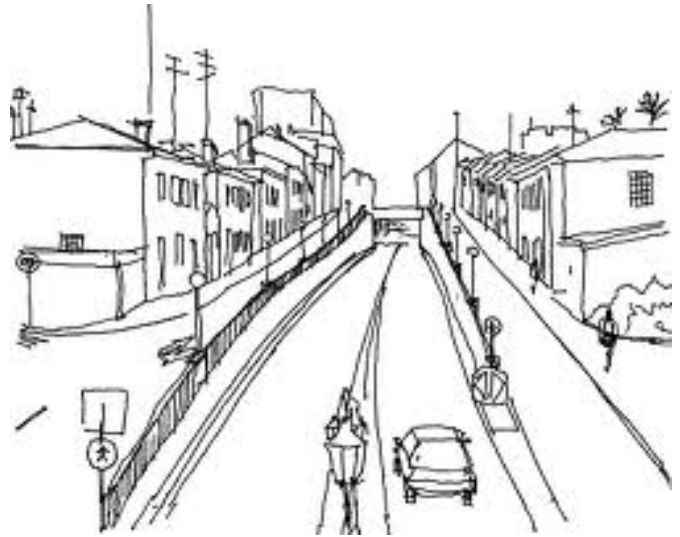

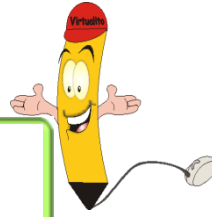
